World Religious Leaders Return From Just Peace Mission to Pray in Kyiv

WARSAW, POLAND - A delegation of world religious leaders has returned from Kiev and Irpinia.

On Friday, May 27, 2022 at 10:00 in Catholic Intelligentsia Club at ul. Freta 20 / 24a (entrance along the street next to the Dominican Church), a press conference will be held with the delegates.

During the conference, European and world Christian, Muslim and Jewish religious leaders will present their reactions to what they saw in Ukraine.

This is the first and, as Archbishop Svyatoslav Shevchuk, the head of the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church said, the most important international and interreligious delegation of this kind to date to visit the capital of Ukraine.

"People start wars. But then they become slaves to war. Then only God can end it. But he needs our cooperation." - said Archbishop Shevchuk during the meeting with delegates.
